

# ...And I Hear **Dragons** activity sheet

## Craft your very own dragon!

### What you'll need:

- 1 x 12-cup egg carton
- 1 x 2-egg cups joined together (from another carton)
- Coloured craft/card paper (about 3 x A4 sheets)
- Coloured paint and paint-brushes or pens
- Black marker pen or black biro
- Scissors
- Ruler
- Sellotape and/or PVA glue

### Instructions:

1. With your scissors, cut the lid off the 12-cup egg carton — the part with the egg cups will be the top of the dragon's mouth and the flat lid will be the bottom of the mouth.
2. Reattach the top part to the bottom part at the back only with tape, so the mouth of your dragon can open and close. Tip: Use a pencil to make two holes in the back of the dragon — you will then be able to move the dragon's mouth with your fingers.
3. Grab two pieces of craft paper and use a pencil to draw out the shape of your wings. Then cut these out. Tip: Draw and cut your first wing and then use that as a template to cut the shape of your second wing.
4. Glue/tape your wings to each side of your dragon.
5. Now, get the 2-cup egg carton and draw some eyes with a black marker pen.
6. Use your glue/tape to attach the 2-cup carton to the top of the dragon's mouth to act as the eyes.
7. Cut out a 10cm (length) by 3cm (width) rectangle from card and cut zig-zags into one of the short edges.
8. Tape/glue this piece of card paper inside the dragon's mouth to create the tongue.
9. Use your marker pen to draw nostrils on your dragon.
10. Enjoy your dragon all summer long!
