Enillodd y nofel, sy'n antur ffantasiol llawn dirgelwch, Wobr Tir na n-Og 2023 yn y categori oed uwchradd.



Alun is from Aberystwyth originally, but he now lives in Cardiff. He is a software engineer. His trilogy of Welsh detective novels for adults – Ar Drywydd Llofrudd, Ar Lwybr Dial, and Ar Daith Olaf are extremely popular. His first novel for readers in their early teens, Manawydan Jones – Y Pair Dadeni, which is a fantasy novel, was published in 2022, and won the Tir na n-Og Award 2023 (Welsh language secondary school age category).

Creodd ac ysgrifennodd *Jam*, cyfres gomedi ar gyfer S4C, a bu hefyd yn ysgrifennu ar gyfresi *Pobol y Cwm* a *Gwaith/Cartref*. Alun addasodd straeon LHDC+ Alice Oseman, *Heartstopper*, i'r Gymraeg dan y teitl *Curiad Coll*.



Alun is a dad, actor, TV and theatre writer and a book adapter. He comes from Neath originally, but now lives in Cardiff with his husband and sons. He won the Wales Theatre Award for Best Playwright in 2016 for his bilingual play, A Good Clean Heart, a play which is currently on WJEC's A Level Drama study list. He created and wrote Jam, his own comedy series for S4C, and has also written on popular TV series such as Pobol y Cwm and Gwaith/Cartref. Alun adapted Alice Oseman's LGBTQ+ Heartstopper stories into Welsh under the title Curiad Coll.
